AWARDS

GRADUATION BALL AWARDS

- 1.0 To be awarded to members of the Graduating Class in recognition of their outstanding achievements during their undergraduate years. The awards that will be given are listed below. Award winners are to be selected by the Grad Class Award Committee with the exception of the Valedictorian who will be voted in by all gradating students. All award nominees must be graduating in the year the award is to be received.
- 2.0 Submissions are to be made on the KUCSC Website and forwarded to the Vice-President Events and the Graduating Class Representative by the administrator of the website.

Class Valedictorian

- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who has made a significant contribution to the King's community during their undergraduate career. This graduating student must possess a positive demeanor and an outstanding presence among their peers. They must also have demonstrated academic success in their field of study, while making an impact at the King's and within the greater community.
- 2.0 This graduating student will be elected by their peers through a secret ballot and will be asked to present a speech at Grad Ball on behalf of the graduating class.
- 3.0 While everyone is welcome to attend Grad Ball and nominate a student for a particular award, students who will be continuing their undergraduate education next year do not qualify to vote. If you have not applied to graduate you will not be allowed to vote.

The KUCSC Excellence Award

- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who exudes dedication and passion for the King's University College Students' Council (KUCSC) and/or a KUCSC club throughout their undergraduate experience. This person must have made a positive contribution to the King's community and in some capacity, enhanced the student experience for others.

The King's Spirit Award



- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who best demonstrates a genuine enthusiasm for King's University College throughout their undergraduate experience. This person must have demonstrated some capacity of involvement in the King's community.

The King's Humanitarian Award

- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who has made strong efforts to benefit humanity within the local and/or global community throughout their undergraduate experience. This person must possess a deep desire to help and serve their earthly brothers and sisters.

The King's Community Life Award

- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who has made a positive contribution to the local and greater community through volunteerism and/or activism work throughout their undergraduate career.
- 2.0 Documentation must be provide an approximate number of hours the nominee has volunteered in the community during their time as a King's student

The King's Religious Life Award

- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who embodies the religious spirit of King's University College. This person must demonstrate involvement within their religion's practices, and possess a spirit of inclusivity and respect for people of other faiths.

The King's Athletic Pride Award

- 1.0 Awarded to one graduating student who has demonstrated passion and devotion towards Western Athletics (whether through intramurals or as a varsity athlete) during their undergraduate experience. This person must have demonstrated success within their respective sport and consistently embody perseverance and sportsmanship.

KUCSC STUDENT AWARDS

KUCSC Golden "K" Award

- 1.0 Can be awarded to a maximum of three (3) students.
- 2.0 The Students must be enrolled at King's University College.



- 3.0 The Award recognizes outstanding contribution to the community both on and off campus as well as excellence in the following areas: academics, dance, fine arts, music, student government, philanthropy, and athletics.
- 4.0 Applications will be open as determine by the KUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 4.1 Applications include: cover letter, academic resume, and a letter outlining extra-curricular activities.
 - 4.2 Selections will be made by the KUCSC Student Awards Committee.
 - 4.3 Award winner(s) will receive a framed document, and have their name(s) engraved on a plaque present on King's campus.
 - 4.3.1 There is no monetary value associated with this award, hence otherwise determined by the KUCSC Student Awards Committee, in consultation with the Finance Committee and Council generally.
 - 4.4 The KUCSC Student Awards Committee oversees the entire application process including verifying the application, awarding the recipient of the award, and the timeline of the entire process. The Committee holds the right not to given an award if it chooses to.

KUCSC Service Award

- 1.0 Will be awarded to special individual(s) who is (are) either recognized as a member of KUCSC, The King's Orientation program, the OC Don Program, the Promo Team, or a KUCSC Club Executive.
- 2.0 Recipient must have completed at least 25 hours of volunteer service.
- 3.0 Applications will be open from a timeline as determined by the KUCSC Student Awards Committee.
- 4.0 Recipient must provide a cover letter and a resume with the application.
- 5.0 Monetary award may or may not be given and is in discretion of the KUCSC Student Awards Committee.
- 6.0 A Certificate must be given to any recipient of the award.
- 7.0 Recipient must hold a volunteer position and not a paid position on the KUCSC.
- 8.0 The KUCSC Student Awards Committee oversees the entire application process including verifying the application, awarding the recipient of the award and the timeline of the entire process. The Committee holds the right to not give an award if it chooses to.

KUCSC TA Award for Excellence



- 1.0 Can be awarded to an official Teaching Assistant (TA)/Tutor as determined by King's faculty.
- 2.0 Each individual TA must have taught for at least one half course (0.5) or must oversee a yearly tutoring program as recognized by individual departments.
- 3.0 Nominations will be made available through the King's Website where students will be able to nominate their recommended TA/Tutor.
- 4.0 The nominated individual can accept/decline the nomination. If the nomination is accepted, the individual needs to provide:
 - 4.1 A curriculum vitae, and
 - 4.2 A short statement of their experience in teaching that particular course/lab or program;
- 5.0 The Professor(s) in charge of the individual must be contacted for reference purposes.
- 6.0 Member(s) of the Committee may choose to audit the individual(s) class or program if needed.
- 7.0 The KUCSC Student Awards Committee oversees the entire application process including awarding the recipient of the award and the timeline for the entire process.
- 8.0 A monetary award of at least \$150 (adjustable to inflation) must be given to the recipient. The monetary value is expected to be matched by the Academic Dean's Office.
- 9.0 A crest must be awarded to the recipient in recognition of this achievement.

KUCSC International Student Award

- 1.0 KUCSC International Award(s) of at least \$500 will be awarded each year for International student involvement in the King's Community.
- 2.0 Award(s) must be given to international student(s) as recognized by the Registrar's Office at King's University College.
- 3.0 Student must be in good standing according to the Academic Dean's Office at King's University College.
- 4.0 General Criteria must be related to student involvement on King's campus.
- 5.0 Nominations, selections, timeline and other details of the award(s) will be overseen by the KUCSC Student Awards Committee.
